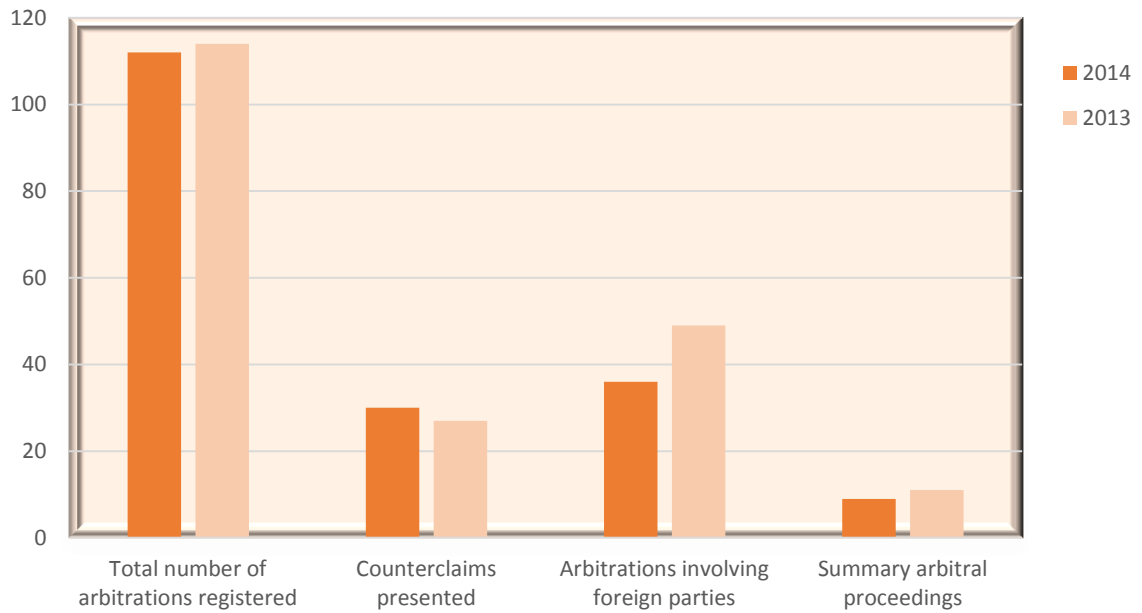


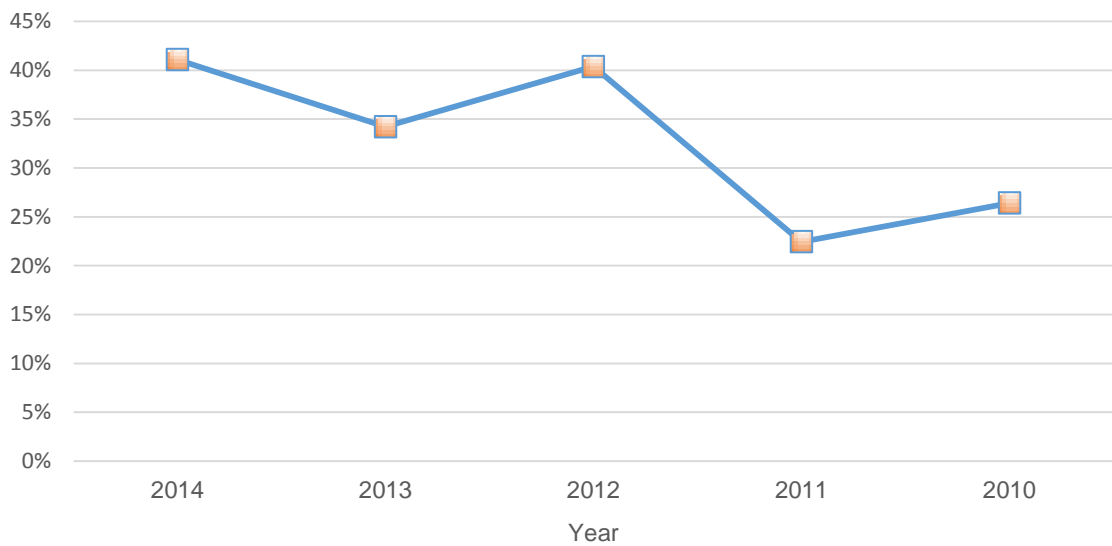
Summary Annual Report 2014

In 2014, 112 arbitrations were requested (versus 114 in 2013), while no mediations were requested in 2014. In 2013, 34% of the cases were settled that same year; this percentage rose to 41% in 2014.

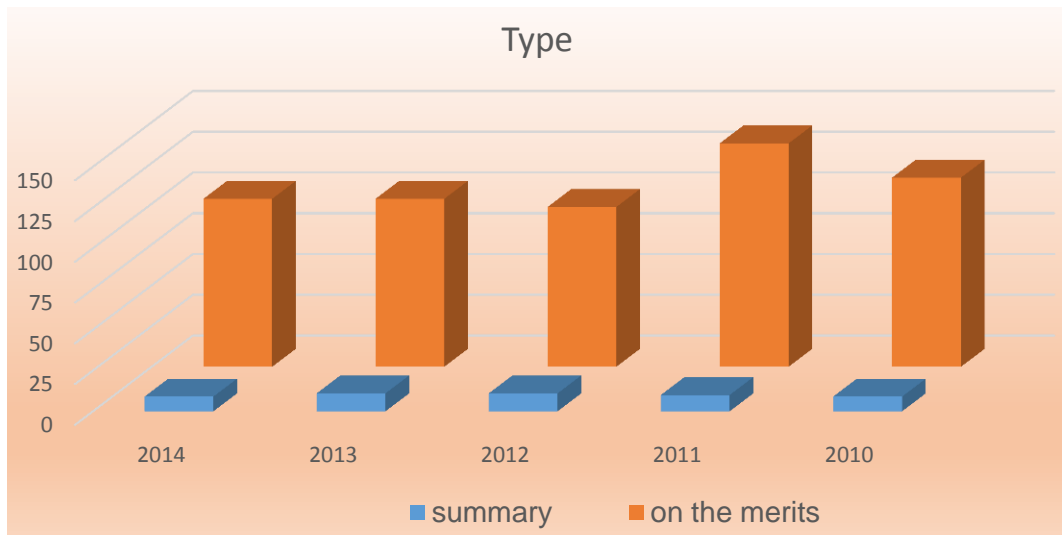

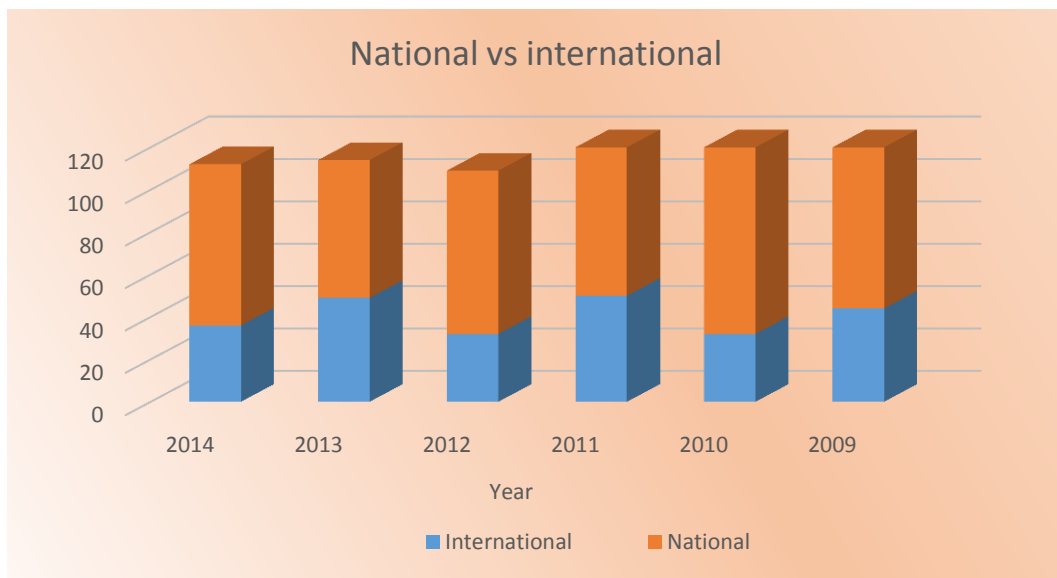

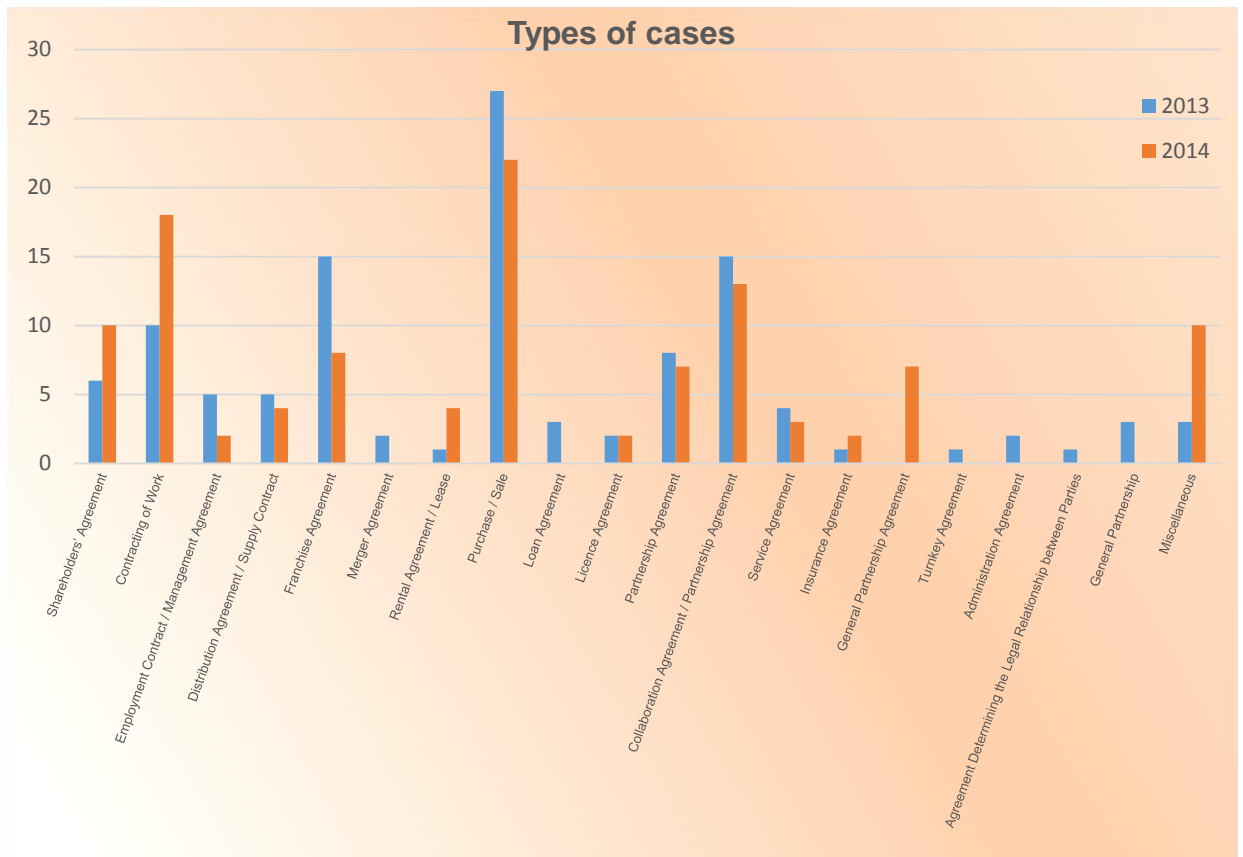
32% of the total number of arbitrations requested were international cases. In 2014, 3 requests for binding advice were received. The binding advice requests are included in the number of arbitrations. In 2014, 9 summary proceedings were initiated according to the 4th Part A.



16 cases were withdrawn during the year under review before the arbitral tribunal was appointed. After the appointment of arbitrators, this involved 15 cases. In 33 cases, the appointment of 1 arbitrator sufficed. This number was 48 in 2013. In 39 cases, 3 arbitrators were appointed, compared to 30 in 2013. In 2014, SCP proceedings (small claims procedure) were used once.
